Notes to P&L:

Financial reports for the Nepali Village Initiatives Association Inc. do not encompass the entire project of this name registered with Rotary Australia World Community Service (RAWCS), as some aspects of the project are conducted by Rotary entities. These include receipts of tax deductible donations by RAWCS and activities conducted by Rotary clubs (Woodend and Portland Bay). Activities in Nepal habe been funded from other sources such as the Australian Embassy. Comparative figures are therefore also shown for the entire project.

- \$13,000 which had been received by RAWCS in 12-13 was passed on to NVIA in 13-14. \$6,535 received by RAWCS in 13-14 was passed on in 14-15 A further \$2,400 was held by RAWCS at the 30 June 2015.
- Grants of \$20,000 were received into Rotary accounts in the years 12-13 and 13-14, and transferred into NVIA accounts in the subsequent years. A grant of \$12.300 that was received by LEARN from the Australian Embassy in 14-15 did not pass through NVIA accounts
- \$2,041 was raised by crowd funding in 13-14 as a contribution to travel costs to Nepal of World Peace Clown Susan Carew.
- 4 Volunteers visiting Nepal cover their own travel expenses. Some but not all of these funds pass through NVIA accounts
- Some expenditures ar paid directly by NVIA to a relevant bnk account in Nepal. In other cases funds are transferred to Nepal as Advances (to be allocated)
 The "Total Project" figures show the outcomes of these allocations, yielding high figures for items auch as teacher training and Volunteer expenses
