

Brief summary of the programs for the 1st year 2017

(The detailed report of each event has been submitted previously to Project manager RC Baglung via KB Shahi, President of RC Baglung)

Orientation Program:

An orientation program was conducted for SMC members and PTA members including Head Teachers. It was conducted in 24th and 25th June 2017 at Sarwodaya Secondary School, Bhurung Tatopani Myagdi. The program was attended by 52 members from 14 schools under the Resource Center. The objective of the program was mainly to aware the members of about their roles and responsibilities the school management committee.

10 days basic training:

“Basic Level Teacher Training Programme-I” in Sarwodaya Secondary School Resource Center, Bhurung Tatopani, Myagdi was conducted from 9th-18th April 2017. District Education Officer inaugurated the program. KB Shahi, President of Rotary Club of Baglung meet the trainer team and encouraged them to make it a success and Peter Hall, President of Quality Education Nepal and member of Rotary Club of Kynetone was present in the closing ceremony. 70 teachers from that Resource Center participated in the training. Main objectives of the training were to;

- Provide the skill of developing the relevant teaching learning materials for effective learning
- Improve existing teaching / learning practice through the development of child-centered teaching learning methods
- Motivate the teachers for their profession

In-school support:

School follow up for instant support activities was carried out from 15th to 23rd June 2017. Objectives of the school visit were to observe the schools whether they have practiced to change the existing school environment. Also the trainer supported the teachers in live class room teaching learning activities, conduct teacher staff meeting and provide feed backs and collect current data record to analyze the outcomes in the future.

6 days refresher training:

6 refresher training was conducted from 4th to 9th September, 2017. 85 teaches took part in the training. There were some reasons in increment in the participants. Though the training was for basic level teachers but some secondary level teachers joint thinking that this will support them in teaching in the secondary level. The another reason is giving opportunity to school sourcing teachers. The refresher training was mainly focused on reviewing the 10 day

basic training, developing more teaching learning materials, learning skills for making classrooms resourceful, and usage of learning materials.
