Annual Summary of the programs on funding of Rotary Global Grant 1525855 for the Year 2017 May to April 2018

Introduction

Rotary Club of Baglung given it's priority on community services such as supporting local community for increasing access to Education, Health, Water & Sanitation and Livelihood development of the rural community people over the past few years. From RY 2016-17 RC Baglung has started Global Grant Project as host sponsor club at Tatopani Resource Centre, Myagdi District, Nepal. The Rotary Club of Portland is the international sponsor club associated with RC Portland Bay and RC Highton (D9780), RC Kyneton and RC Keilor East (D9800), and RC Cooroy. RC Gympie and RC Gympie Cooloola (D9600). The other associating clubs are RC Parbat, RC Pokhara Fishtail, RC Pokhara Annapurna, RC Pokhara Midtown and RC Lekhnath. LEARN is the cooperating organization of this project. It's involvement in this project is to financial and operational review /audit by the Rotary Foundation.

The aim of this project is to train, over a period of three years, approximately 75 teachers from 14 communities (government) schools of the Tatopani Resource Centre, Myagdi District, Western Nepal, in child-friendly techniques, so that the children of their schools can receive quality education. Better education is the surest pathway out of poverty for this most impoverished of nations.

10 days teacher training program

This training program was held at Sarwodaya Secondary School Resource Center, Tatopani Myagdi. It was conducted from 9th April to 18th April 2017. This first training was focused in the basic requirement of child-centered education environment such as child friendly classroom management, materials preparation and use, classroom teaching learning strategies and so on. LEARN focuses on the importance of the team approach in bringing the quality education through the practice of child centered learning methods in the schools.

Training objectives:

- To improve existing teaching / learning practice through the development of child-centered teaching learning methods
- To provide relevant and appropriate teaching materials and resources to schools to address diverse learning needs
- To motivate teachers for their profession

School Management Committee Chairperson Bduddhi Bahadur Pun chaired the opening ceremony. The training programme was inaugurated by DEO Ram Kumar Shrestha, Head Teacher of the training centre school, Sim Bahadur Pun welcomed all the participants and DEO officials in the programme. Salma Limbu Subba, treasurer of LEARN, observed and supported the management during the entire training time. Rotarian KB Shahi, manager of the RGG project from Rotary Club of Baglung managed to come on the opening day by afternoon and observed the training halls and interacted with the trainer team.

In-School support Program (School follow up)

This program was the second part of the first cycle. This was conducted from 1st Asar to 10th Asar 2074. Out of 14 schools under the resource center the team succeeded to observe 12 because the summer vacation was started and some schools were closed. Those remaining schools will be completed later. After completion of the 10 days training for the teachers they come to school to practice of what they have learnt and inspired in the training.

Objectives of the school visit:

- To observe the reflection of the training practices
- To interact with the teachers and solve the problem on the spot
- To interact with the students whether there seems to have some changes and check the level of the students learning standard
- To collect current data of student and their learning achievement
- To collect the needs and expectation for the coming programs and training

SMC/PTA/HT Orientation Program

This is a part of the associated program of the whole package. LEARN conducted a 2 days orientation program at Sarwodaya Secondary School, Tatopani Myagdi for the SMC and PTA representatives together with the head teachers. It was conducted on 11th and 12th of Asar 2074.

Objectives:

- To aware roles and responsibilities of SMC members, PTA members, Head teachers as they are in the management role
- To aware about the child friendly school environment and manage accordingly
- To aware of government funding for schools and local resources mobilization
- To aware current roles of the school management under local government

Phase-II basic 10 days training program

Rotarian KB Shahi, Manager of the RGG project and Rotarian Purna Bahadur KC the President from Rotary Club of Baglung attended the opening program of Phase –II 10 days training and observed and monitoring the training halls and interacted with the trainer team.
